## 1- General context

The Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC), a vast country in central Africa with an area of **2,345 million km<sup>2</sup>** and a population estimated at more **than 100 million inhabitants**, has considerable human and natural potential. However, the country faces many socio-economic challenges, of which the health system remains a key pillar for human development.

## 2- Organization and actors of the health system

The health system is structured according to **a three-level pyramid**:

- **The peripheral level**, corresponding to the **health zone**, constitutes the basic operational unit. It provides direct care to the population.
- **The intermediate level**, represented by **the Provincial Health Division (DPS)**, plays a role of supervision, coordination and technical support to the health zones.
- **The central level** is responsible for policy formulation, **strategic planning and regulation** of the health system.



The **healthcare offer** remains fragmented, with a **strong involvement of the private sector**, particularly in urban areas. In parallel, **community health workers contribute** significantly to the provision of basic care, particularly in rural areas.

**Faith-based organizations** are also prominent in the system, managing a significant proportion of **health care facilities** and actively collaborating with the public sector through health partnerships.

### **3- Human resources for health**

#### **Main categories:**

General practitioners and specialists; Nurses and senior health technicians; Biologists, pharmacists, physiotherapists, etc.



## 4- Recent initiatives

### 1. Universal Health Coverage (UHC)

**Universal Health Coverage (UHC)** is today one of the priority projects of the Head of State materialized by the government. It aims to guarantee every citizen equitable access to quality healthcare, while ensuring financial protection against catastrophic expenses related to the disease.

### 2. Pillars of UHC

Among the main areas of implementation, there is **free healthcare for pregnant women and children**, an emblematic measure launched in 2023. This initiative marks the first step in a gradual process aimed at extending free health coverage to the entire population.



## Conclusion

The health sector in DRC is a vital pillar of national development. Despite considerable challenges, the efforts of government, private actors (**CDE**) and technical partners aim to make the system more **efficient and fair**.

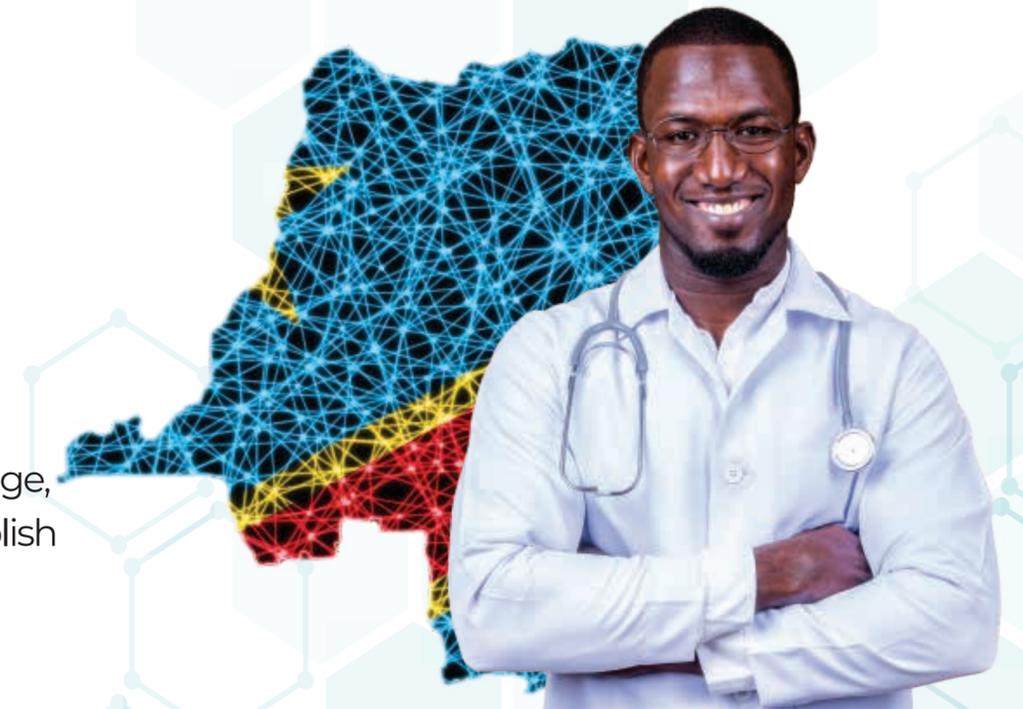
